- Locate and apply relevant documentation, policies and procedures
- Demonstrate completion of entering and working in confined spaces
- Obtain appropriate entry permit and instructions for performing work in confined space
- Interpret and applying safe work method statements
- Setup confined space and undertake tagging and lock out
- Select, wear and maintain personal protective equipment applicable to all tasks and environment identified
- Use of atmospheric monitoring devices
- Undertake work in the confined space
- Apply safe materials handling methods
- Identify areas that constitute confined spaces
- Setup site and equipment safety requirements
- Demonstrate and comply with entry and exit procedures, risks and regulations
- Understand types of air contaminants and toxic gases
- Identify the limitations of breathing apparatus
- Identify confined space equipment types, characteristics, technical capabilities and limitations
- Undertake isolations and site control responsibilities and authorities
- Identify the theoretical and Practical Assessments.
