



## COURSE OVERVIEW

### TLILIC2001 – LICENCE TO OPERATE A FORKLIFT TRUCK

This course is designed to ensure that participants have the skills and knowledge required for the operation of a powered industrial truck equipped with a mast and an elevating load carriage to which is attached a pair of fork arms or other attachment, for licensing purposes. This definition also includes a truck on which the operator is raised with the attachment for order-picking.

This course is based on the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work.

- Plan work
- Conduct routine checks
- Set up elevating work platform
- Operate elevating work platform
- Shut down and secure elevating work platform.

## COURSE CONTENT:

- Operate a slewing mobile crane up to 100 tonnes capacity
- Undertake hazard identification and implement control measures
- Follow work orders and confirm lift plans
- Conduct routine inspections and maintenance in accordance with manufacturer's specification
- Complete Logbooks and review relevant crane compliance documentation
- Interpret the Rated Capacity of the crane from load charts and range diagrams
- Input data into the crane computer to reflect the crane's configuration for lifting requirements
- Identify and establish appropriate paths of travel for load placement
- Configure the crane for both travel and crane lifting operations
- Conduct a test lift in accordance with dogging and safe work procedures
- Shift loads in a safe manner within the Rated Capacities of the load charts and lift plans
- Understand factors affecting slewing mobile crane stability whilst mobiling loads compared to non-slewing mobile cranes, vehicle loading cranes and reach stackers
- Communicate effectively with other team members, including Dogman/Rigger
- Pack up and perform a shutdown of the crane.
